

Level 2 Award in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Automated External Defibrillation (QCF) *

Course Aim

To enable Learners to attain the knowledge and competencies needed to deal with Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED) in a safe, prompt, effective manner in emergency situations

Who is it for?

An AED (automated external defibrillator) in the workplace is an invaluable addition to health and safety provision for your employees as they are proven to save lives. With installation of any AED we highly recommend you train personnel in its usage.

Course Content

Understand basic life support

- CPR techniques, AED and the recovery position in line with current national guidelines.
- Choking casualty
- Safe use of an AED
- Recovery position
- Basic user maintenance and troubleshoot problems with an AED
- Safety considerations when using AEDs

Course Duration

6 hours of training over 1 day.

Assessment and Qualification

Ongoing practical assessment by the trainer.
