

Level 3 Award in Paediatric Emergency First Aid (QCF)*

Course Aim

To enable delegates to attain a first aid qualification that meets the requirements of the Ofsted Voluntary Register. It is not normally accepted for those wishing to work within the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

Who is it for?

Nannies and anyone who wants an overview of first aid for children and babies.

Course Content

- Identify the Responsibilities of a Paediatric First Aider
- Assess An Emergency Situation And Act Safely And Effectively
- Unresponsive Child and Infant (Recovery Position)
- Child and Infant CPR
- Seizures
- Foreign Body Airway Obstruction
- Choking Child And Infant
- Wounds And Bleeding
- Minor Injuries
- Shock Including Anaphylactic Shock

Course Duration

6 hours of training over 1 day.

Assessment and Qualification

Ongoing practical assessment by the trainer and a multi-choice questionnaire.

All students are awarded a recognised First Aid Certificate which is valid for 3 years as well as a first aid manual and pocket card.
